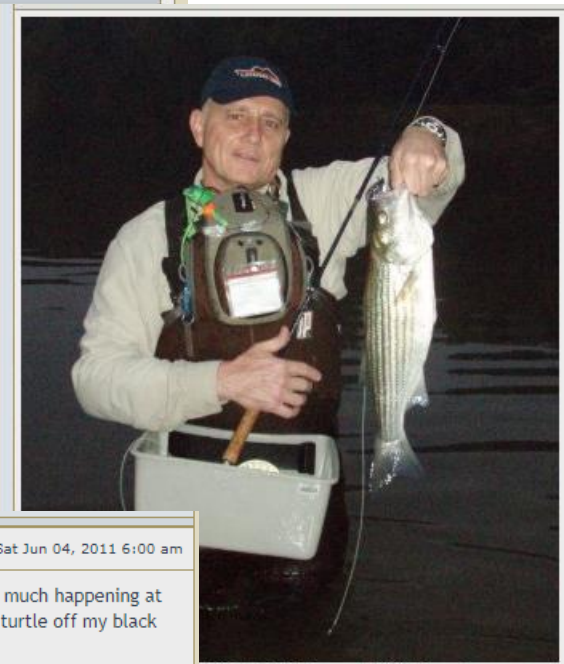
Following a late "Let's Go Fishing" call on Monday evening, three of us showed up at the power lines downstream Old Mill Park. I started fishing at 4pm and caught my first two fish at 5pm., just before Steve and Gary arrived. We fished in the company of eagles and herons. From 5 to about 8 we caught an average of 20 stripers each, including several 16", a few 18"-20" and one 23" (picture attached). Lost some nice ones. There were plenty of fish in the water, many just passing downstream. Best fly: small clouser (size 6). Most fish caught just 2-3' under the surface.

Water temperature 1-2 feet below the surface is 81 degrees and it was gin clear. Not much happening at all. Elio got a minature Striper, the size of his bubba fly. I now have bragging rights for a painted turtle. Think it was bigger than Elio's;) Didn't get a picture as I had my hands full trying to get an angry turtle off my black over blue gonzo fly. While they do provide for some pullage they definetly don't move as fast as a fish. A turtle on an eight weight fights like something between a submerged stick and a fish.
