

Went on a Rappahannock trip today. 4th time I've gone fishing this week but the first time I've caught anything worth mentioning. The previous times the water has been too stained from the rain last saturday to catch very


I put in at Motts at about 8:00 and went upstream about a mile, fishing along the way. Early in the morning the bass were hanging out near rock ledges next to the sandy bottom. Later they were in the riffles. I caught them on a #4 foam slider (yelllow). I also tried fishing deep with a crayfish pattern but no luck with that. Caught about 15 of them over the course of 4 hrs. no real size to any of them. Water visibility was about 3-4 feet and the water was a good temp, I'd guess about 80 deg. I've posted a picture of a typical one below.

I also found one of the most interesting pieces of river garbage I've ever found. it was an ugly hunk of aluminum with the markings US LF&C 1918. I'm not a history buff, but junk that is almost 100 yrs old in the river can pique my interest. I looked it up when I got home. It's an old military issue canteen in very poor shape. Its a real piece of treasure. in good condition on ebay they go for \$10!. Something tells me this one is probably worth more as scrap metal though.

Also, I saw Chip as I was leaving. He said he wasn't catching much either.
