



Tanzania Tigers

The Plan

- Oct 3-4 Fly from DC to Dubai (12½ hours) to Dar es Salaam (5½ hours), stay overnight
- Oct 5 Fly to Tengo Camp (2½ hours), fish ½ day on Ruhudji River
- Oct 6-7 Fish 2 full days on Ruhudji River
- Oct 8 Fish ½ day on Ruhudji River, drive to Mnyera River camp (2½ hours)
- Oct 9-11 Fish 2 full days on Mnyera River, return to Tengo Camp (2½ hours), stay overnight
- Oct 12-13 Fly from Tengo Camp to Dar es Salaam to Dubai to DC

Recommended Gear

- Fast action 9-wt rod + spare
- Large arbor direct drive reel with strong drag
- 150 yards of 30-lb backing (heavier preferred)
- Rio Big Game Leviathan 300-gr fly line + tropical intermediate fly line
- 2/0, 3/0 and 4/0 streamer flies
- Tropical, quick-dry clothing
- Sun protection

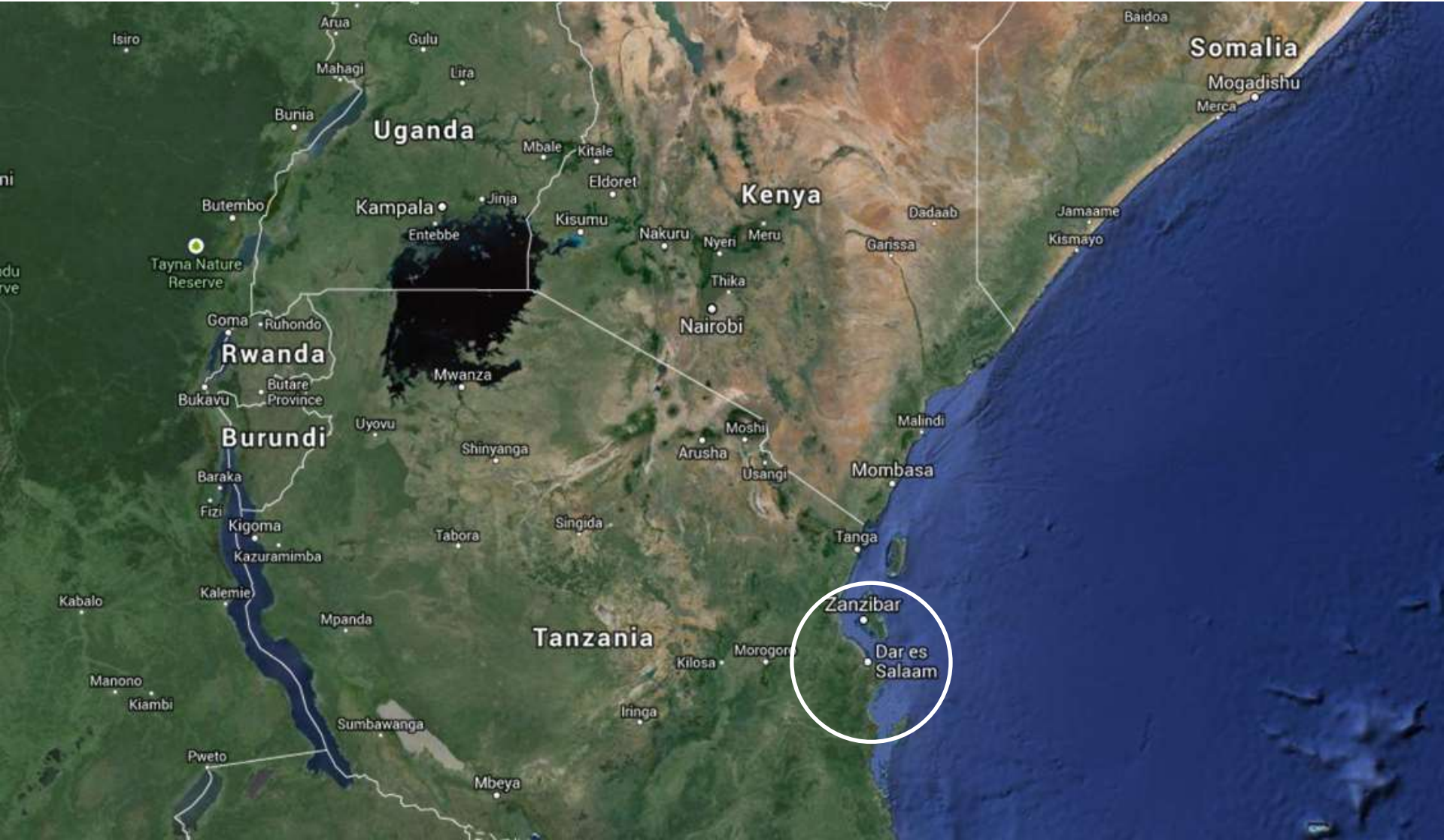
